Join us at our friendly (all-on-one-site) festival, in the beautiful grounds of the OC Sports and Leisure Club where real ale and food are available plus on-site caravanning and camping with showers.

See some of your old favourites and perhaps discover some new artists.

Arrive early if you wish (campsite opens 12noon Thursday 3rd June) and either relax on site, visit some of the Wirral peninsula's wonderful beaches, or perhaps consider visiting the scenic and historic villages of Parkgate, Port Sunlight and Thornton Hough.

Chester and Liverpool are a short train ride away from nearby Bromborough Rail Station.

Travel Directions

Travelling via the M53 motorway:-

Leave the motorway at junction 5 and take the A41 (New Chester Road) towards Eastham and Birkenhead. NB: Watch the speed cameras quite soon after you join this road.

At the second set of traffic lights (immediately after the shops), turn left into Bridle Road. Half a mile on, the OC Club is on the left just past the keep left sign in the middle of the road and just before the traffic lights ahead.

Travelling from the north via the Birkenhead exit of the Mersey Tunnel:-

As you exit the tunnel take the left pay booths immediately ahead.

Follow the green sign indicating North Wales and Chester (A41 – New Chester Road).

Travel along this road and at the second roundabout take first left on to the Rock Ferry by-pass to its end and then take second left at the roundabout back onto the New Chester Road.

Look out for the Village Hotel (on left) and further on the large Matalan store (on right).

At the next set of traffic lights by the church and petrol station, turn right into Allport Road. Travel to the traffic lights and turn left into Bridle Road.

You will find the entrance to the OC Club second on the right about two hundred yards along Bridle Road.
